- The Holiday Program is conducted in Kigali at Little Bears Montessori School at Kimihurura next to sundowner. The training starts as you clear your registration to 20th December 2019. Only children between 8–15 years of age are taking part in the training.
- With spelling, the words are got from all the subjects e.g. English, Science. Social Studies and Mathematics majorly from the Merriam-Webster dictionary.
- Best spellers will win many prizes including certificates of participation.
